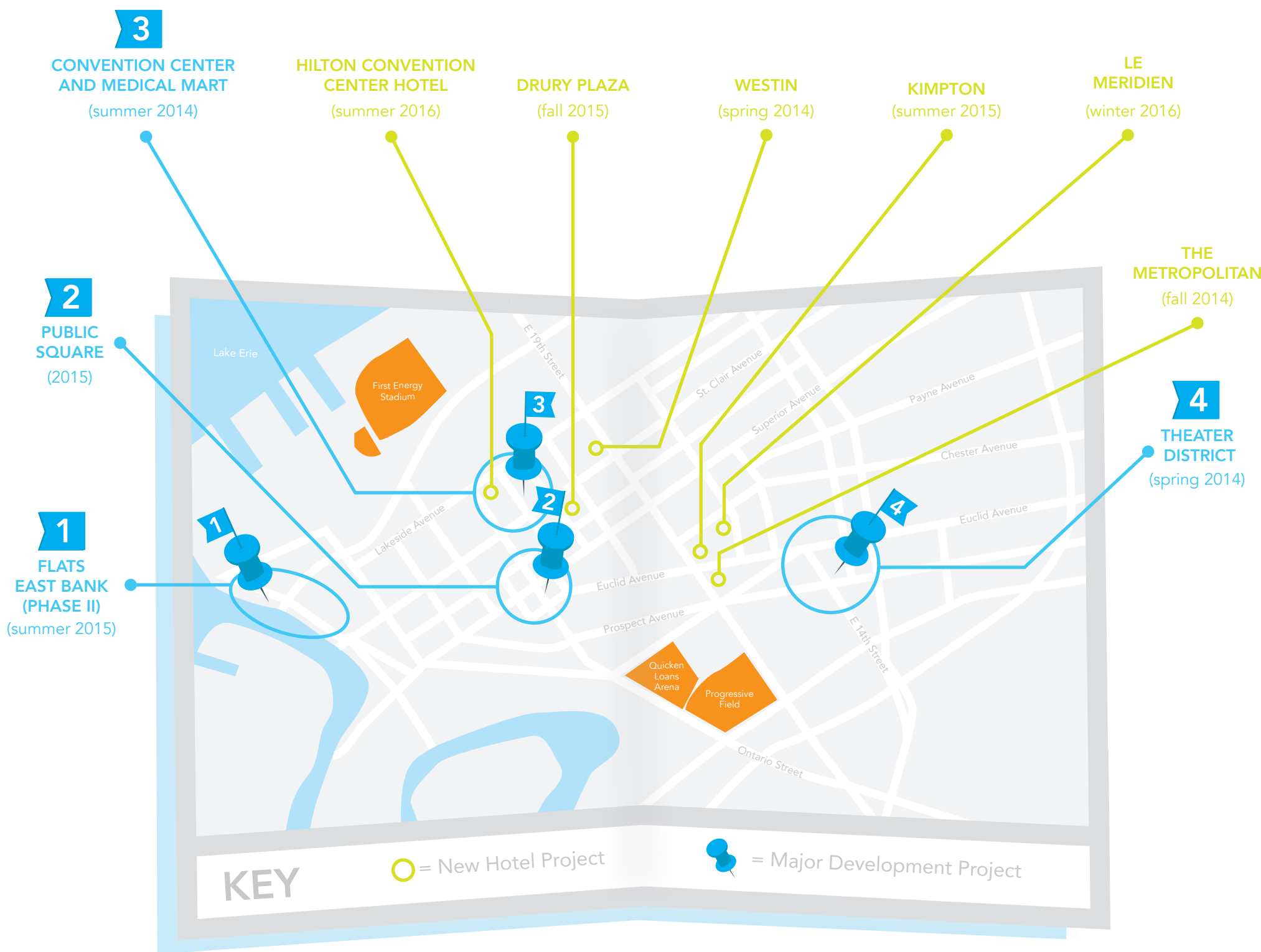
Why everyone should have their eyes on Cleveland:

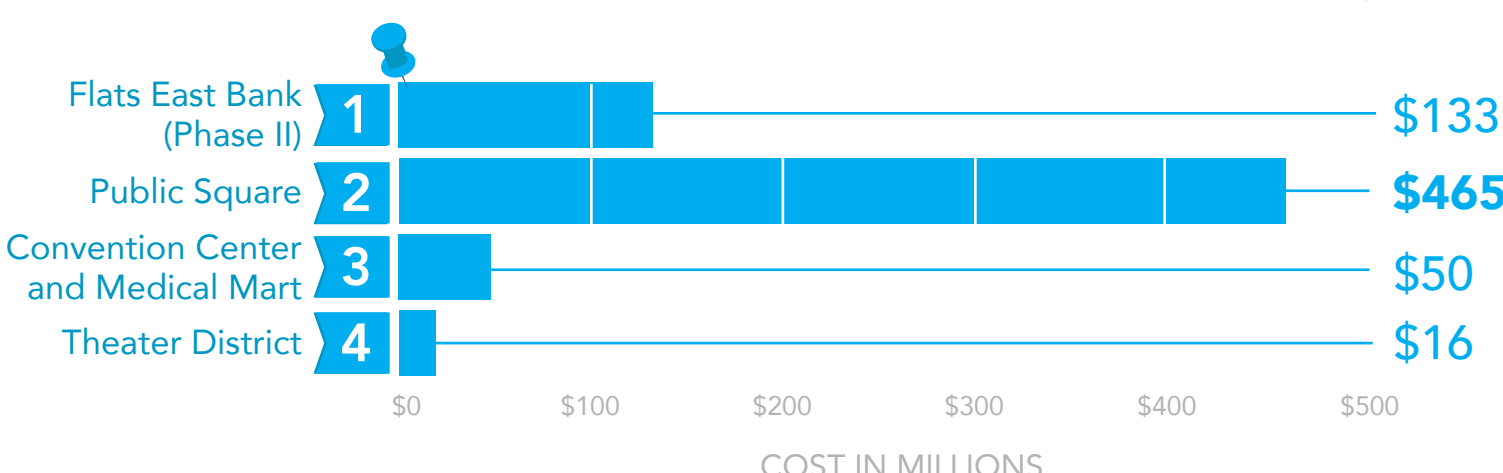
WHAT'S NEW

INVESTMENT TOTALS

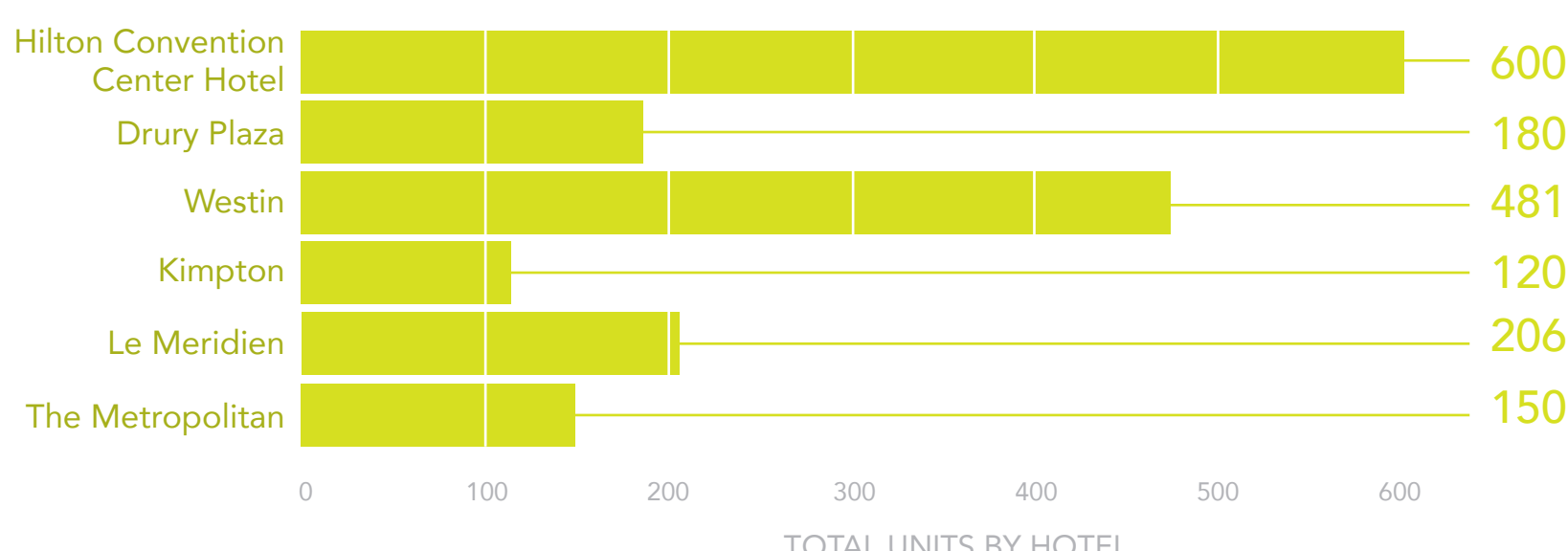

RESIDENCY

More and more people are moving Downtown and housing occupancy rates are the highest they have been in more than 6 decades.



Downtown Cleveland's housing occupancy rate is more than **95% PERCENT** with nearly **12,000 PEOPLE LIVING IN THE CITY.**

TRANSIT

Downtown Cleveland has more transit options than any other city in Ohio.



The free trolley runs **7 days** a week, **every ten minutes**, until 11pm, carrying about 5,000 passengers per day.



Cleveland is the most walkable city in Northeast Ohio, with a Walkscore® of **87/100**.



Daily parking rates are at least **50% lower** than the national average, with some spots as low as **\$3 per day**.
